Leadership and Diversity in the 21st Century: Shared Society in Israel and the Galilee

June 16 - July 2, 2024

Location: Oranim College, Israel

Oranim International, in partnership with UC International, invites applications for a new immersive undergraduate program on modern Israel and the rich history and diverse cultures of the Galilee, with a focus on equity, inclusion, and democracy.

Co-taught by Oranim and UC faculty, the program is based at Oranim College, located in northern Israel on the outskirts of the city of Haifa. Core classes: (a) "Contemporary Israel," (b) "Communities of the Galilee," and (c) "Leadership for Social Change and Shared Society." Other program components include weekly electives, meetings with Galilee activists and thought leaders from different walks of life, and field trips to Galilee historical sites, towns, and cities (Tiberias, Nazareth, Safed).

Tuition: \$2,800 USD / 4 credits

- Tuition includes academic instruction, housing, lunch (Sunday to Friday), field trips, daily shuttle to/from Oranim College, and official transcript upon completion of program.
- Participants will lodge in a renovated historic hotel in Haifa's lively downtown port area, equipped with kitchen facility
- Students are responsible for their own international travel to/from Israel
