Oranim College hosted an online forum for the Anna Lindh Foundation Israeli Network members and facilitated engagement among network affiliates to set the Anna Lindh Israeli Network's thematic priorities.

Comprehensive invitations and registration forms were disseminated to all members, ensuring broad participation in the deliberative process. This inclusive virtual assembly aimed to democratically ascertain the network's thematic priorities. Before the meeting, participants were given the opportunity to rank their respective fields of interest, thereby establishing a structured framework conducive to transparent decision-making that reflects collective preferences.

The online meeting commenced with a presentation of the priorities, collating insights from participating organizations. Subsequently, representatives engaged in constructive dialogue, articulating rationales indicating their preferences while exploring potential intersections among thematic areas. Through facilitated discussions, participants delved into the nuances of their chosen priorities.

Following thorough deliberation, the group reached consensus on the thematic priorities:

- Interreligious and Intercultural Dialogue
- Active Citizenship
- Gender

These thematic domains are deemed priorities for future collective action. Notably, the decision-making process remained inclusive, with representatives from diverse organizations actively contributing to discussions and reaffirming their commitment to the identified priorities.
